### **Ready for AI? Why Governance Is the Missing Piece in Your Microsoft 365 Copilot Strategy**

This is the last of a 3-part series examining redundant, obsolete, and trivial information assets, the risks ROT presents to your organization, and how information governance (IG) is essential to reduce ROT and realize the benefits of AI.

In the first part of this series, “Why Your Digital Clutter Is Costing You ROI1 — and What to Do About It,” I talked about cleaning up ROT. In the second part, “Your Information Architecture Is Failing You—Here’s What to Do About It,” I talked about fixing the foundation and re-architecting your information landscape in order to move from ROT to ART content. However, here’s the key determinant of success: AI won’t succeed without governance.

As more organizations adopt Microsoft 365 Copilot, many assume the tool alone will solve productivity and knowledge management challenges. But Microsoft 365 Copilot

isn't a magician — it can't organize your content, secure your data, or classify documents for you. To truly succeed with AI, you need to start where it matters most: governance.

### **Microsoft 365 Copilot Can't Fix What It Can't Understand**

Microsoft 365 Copilot is powerful — but it's only as smart as the content it can access and the context it's given. Without proper governance, Microsoft 365 Copilot may:

- Surface outdated or inaccurate information
- Pull from non-compliant or sensitive sources
- Provide poor recommendations due to incomplete content
- Amplify security and privacy risks through incorrect permissions and access rights

In other words, without governance, you risk enabling AI-powered chaos and exposing sensitive information,

at scale.

### **Governance: The Foundation for Secure and Compliant AI**

Governance helps ensure that the right people access the right content at the right time — and with the right security and permissions in place to mitigate the risks of data losses and data breaches. It's what turns AI from a liability into a strategic advantage. A governance-first approach to Microsoft 365 Copilot means:

- Classifying and labeling sensitive data using Microsoft Purview

- Applying lifecycle policies, so Microsoft 365 Copilot accesses accurate, reliable, and trusted (ART2) content, instead of ROT
- Structuring information so prompts yield meaningful and compliant outputs
- Engaging end-users with clear guidelines and ethical AI training

Without this foundation, Microsoft 365 Copilot can't deliver meaningful outcomes and achieve the expected ROI — and may even expose your organization to unnecessary risk.

**Wait, Was I Supposed to Be Taking Notes?**

We've all been there. The meeting drones on, your attention wanders, and suddenly someone says, "John, what do you think?" You scramble for the mute button, hoping your camera's off. Somewhere in the background, the meeting is being recorded, preserving both the important discussion and your moment of panic.

It's funny until you realize that the recording may be an official record, subject to laws, retention schedules, and legal discovery. What began as a safety net for our shrinking attention spans has quietly become a records management minefield.

### **Why we hit "record"**

Recent studies suggest the average person's attention span during digital work is about 47 seconds before switching tasks.[1] Microsoft's 2023 Work Trend Index similarly found that constant notifications and multitasking have eroded deep focus. We record meetings because we know we'll get distracted—and because digital platforms make it effortless.

The convenience feels harmless. But each time we press "record," we may be creating a record with legal and operational implications. Whether you use Teams, Zoom, Google Meet, or another platform, those recordings don't vanish when the meeting ends. They live in your organization's cloud, often without clear rules for retention or deletion.

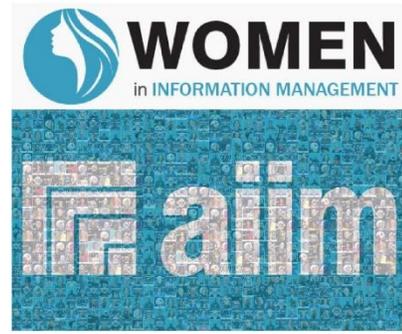
